
Sub : Reservation of seats for Physically Challenged candidates for admission to Diploma Course in Govt. and Govt. Sponsored Polytechnics

The undersigned is directed to say that in all admission processes of WBSCT&VE&SD for Government & Government Sponsored Polytechnics, 3% of total seats has been kept reserved for the persons with disabilities (PC / PwD) .

Consequent upon enactment of RPwD Act, 2016, it is required to revise the statutory reservation of seats for the persons with disabilities for admission to Diploma Courses in Govt. and Govt. Sponsored Polytechnics.

After careful consideration of the matter the undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that the Governor has been pleased to raise the reservation of seats for the persons with disabilities (PC / PwD) for admission to Diploma courses in Govt. and Govt. Sponsored Polytechnics from 3% to not less than 4% as per provision contained in Section 34(1) and (2) of RPwD Act , 2016.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority of the Department.


