MEMORANDUM

Sub: Entry Point Qualification, Entry Pay and certain other benefits for the post of Principals & Lecturers of Govt. and Govt. Sponsored Polytechnics in West Bengal

Consequent upon AICTE's regulation vide The Gazette of India: Extraordinary [Part III—Sec. 4], New Delhi No. 61-1/RIFD/7th CPC/2016-17 dated March 01, 2019 and subsequent AICTE's Notification vide F. No. 61-3/RIFD/7th CPC/2016-17 dt. 20.05.2020 and in continuation of this Department's Order No. 1412-TET(poly) dated 24/12/2019 read with the Order No. 53-TET(poly) dated 20/01/2020 and Corrigendum no. 60-TET(poly) dated 21/01/2020, the undersigned is directed to say that the Governor has been pleased to accord approval for entry point qualification, entry pay and certain other benefits in the revised Pay Structures in respect of Principals & Lecturers of Government and Government Sponsored Polytechnics in West Bengal.

1. Entry point qualification and entry pay:

A. For Direct Recruitment of Lecturer (Level - 9A, Entry Pay 56,100/-)

Those possessing a minimum of 4-year Bachelor's degree shall be placed in Level 9A at entry pay of Rs 56,100/-

- a. Engineering / Technology: B. E. / B. Tech. / B.S. in relevant discipline with First Class or equivalent.
- b. Pharmacy: B. Pharm. with First Class or equivalent.
- c. Hotel Management and Catering Technology: A minimum 4-year Bachelor's Degree in HMCT with First Class or equivalent.
- d. Architecture: B.Arch. or a 4-year Degree in an allied field with First Class or equivalent.
- e. Fine Arts: Bachelor's degree in appropriate discipline of Fine Arts (Applied Arts, Painting and Sculpture) or equivalent with First Class or equivalent.
- f. **Design:** Bachelor's degree in design or a minimum 4-year Diploma in any one of the streams of Design, Fine Arts, Applied Arts and Architecture or Bachelor's degree in Engineering with First Class or equivalent
- **g. Sciences and Humanities:** Master's degree in relevant subject with First Class or equivalent at Bachelor's or Master's level.

B. For Direct Recruitment of Lecturer (Level - 10, Entry Pay Rs 57,700/-)

i. For Technical Disciplines: Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in relevant disciplines with First Class in either of the two at the time of selection.

ii. For Sciences and Humanities: A Master's degree with First Class in relevant subject and, must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET / SET.

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2. For movement of incumbent Lecturer from Level 9A to Level 10

a. For Technical disciplines:

A lecturer shall be placed in Level 10 at suitable cell as and when the candidate acquires the Master's degree in relevant Technical discipline.

b. For Sciences and Humanities

A lecturer shall be placed in Level 10 at suitable cell as and when the candidate clears the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET / SET.

c. For Lecturers of both disciplines without having acquired qualification as at (a) and/or (b) above

It case candidates do not acquire relevant Master's degree in the case of Technical disciplines and in case of candidates from Sciences and Humanities do not clear National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET / SET, they shall be placed in appropriate cell of level 10 only after completion of 5 years.

3. Incentives for Ph.D./ M.Phil and other Higher Qualification:

i) Five non-compounded advance increments under Level 10 as depicted in Cell No. 1 to 6 under level 10 of the Revised Pay Matrix (Annexure - I)] shall be admissible at the entry level of a recruitee as a Lecturer possessing a degree of Ph.D. awarded in the relevant discipline by a recognized University following the due process of admission test, course work and external evaluation as prescribed by the UGC or the admission process adopted by the institutes established under the Act of Parliament or students having valid GATE / GPAT score for admission to Ph.D. under National Doctoral Fellowship program of AICTE / Prime Minister's Research Fellowship program.

ii) Those possessing Master's degree in Engineering/ Technology/ Architecture/ Planning/ Pharmacy/ Design/Town Planning etc. recognized by the relevant statutory body / council, shall be entitled to two non-compounded advance increments at the entry level.

iii) Teachers who complete their Ph.D. degree while in service as lecturer shall be entitled to three non-compounded increments fixed at increment applicable at entry level under Level 10 as Lecturer only, as depicted in Cell No. 1 to 4 under level 10 of the Revised Pay Matrix (Annexure - I), if such Ph.D. is in a relevant discipline of the discipline of employment and has been awarded by a recognized University following the due process of admission test, course work and external evaluation as prescribed by the UGC or the admission process adopted by the institutes established under the Act of Parliament or students having valid GATE / GPAT score for admission to Ph.D. or students selected for Ph.D. program under Quality Improvement Program (QIP) / Teacher Research Fellowship (TRF).

iv) The above incentives shall be admissible with actual financial effect from 01.01.2020. No arrears of pay which may be admissible in respect of the period from the 1st day of January, 2016 to the 31st day of December, 2019, shall be paid.

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4. Effective date of application of Service Conditions:

The qualifications, experience, other service conditions of the incumbent who is eligible for promotions and movement from one level to another during 01.01.2016 to 23.12.2019 shall be governed by this Department order No: 574-TET(Poly)/5P-1/2010 dated 13.09.2010 and subsequent orders, if issued, from time to time.

- i. In terms of G.O. No. 1412-TET (Poly) dated 24.12.2019, all employees under the purview of this order come under the revised pay structure w.e.f. 01.01.2016. Reexercising option to come under the revised pay structure w.e.f. the date of awarding of CAS shall not be allowed in respect of whom CAS benefits is admissible between 01.01.2016 to 24.12.2019. For such teachers, after fixation of pay in the revised pay structure w.e.f. 01.01.2016 fixation of pay in respect of CAS benefit will be made as per normal rules.
- ii. The lecturers who have joined after 01.01.2016 shall be fitted at the initial cell of the respective level.
- iii. The pay matrix table vide this Department's Order No. 1412-TET(poly) dated 24/12/2019 read with the Order No. 53-TET(poly) dated 20/01/2020 and Corrigendum no. 60-TET(poly) dated 21/01/2020 will stand modified and the revised pay matrix table is appended in **Annexure–I**.

5. Bunching of increments for Principals/ Lecturers:

In cases where in revision of pay, the pay of Government Servant drawing pay at two or more stages in pre-revised Pay Band and Grade Pay or scale, as the case may be, get fixed at sar e Cell in the applicable Level in the new Pay Matrix, one additional increment shall be given for every two stages bunched and the pay of Government Servant drawing higher pay in the pre-revised structure shall be fixed at the next vertical cell in the applicable level, as illustrated below:
